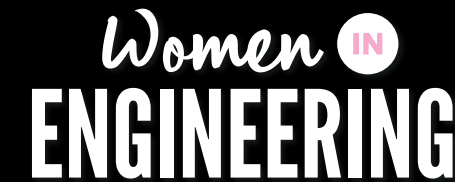

The second development in 2025 was the introduction of the updated contracting law (Law No. 7), under which all contractors operating in Dubai have to be classified based on their expertise, qualifications and whether they have the resources to take on a project. Further, the law stipulates that any sub-contracts can be awarded only after prior approval.

There is no disputing the fact that best practices in consultancy and contracting services represent two important pillars that hold up such targets as greater energy efficiency (towards lowering emissions and the Total Cost of Ownership (TCO)), reliability and Indoor Environmental Quality (IEQ). In view of this, the Conference hears consultants and contractors speak on their concerns and explore the pathway to an enabling environment for them to sustain their businesses and to offer the best-in-class solutions.
